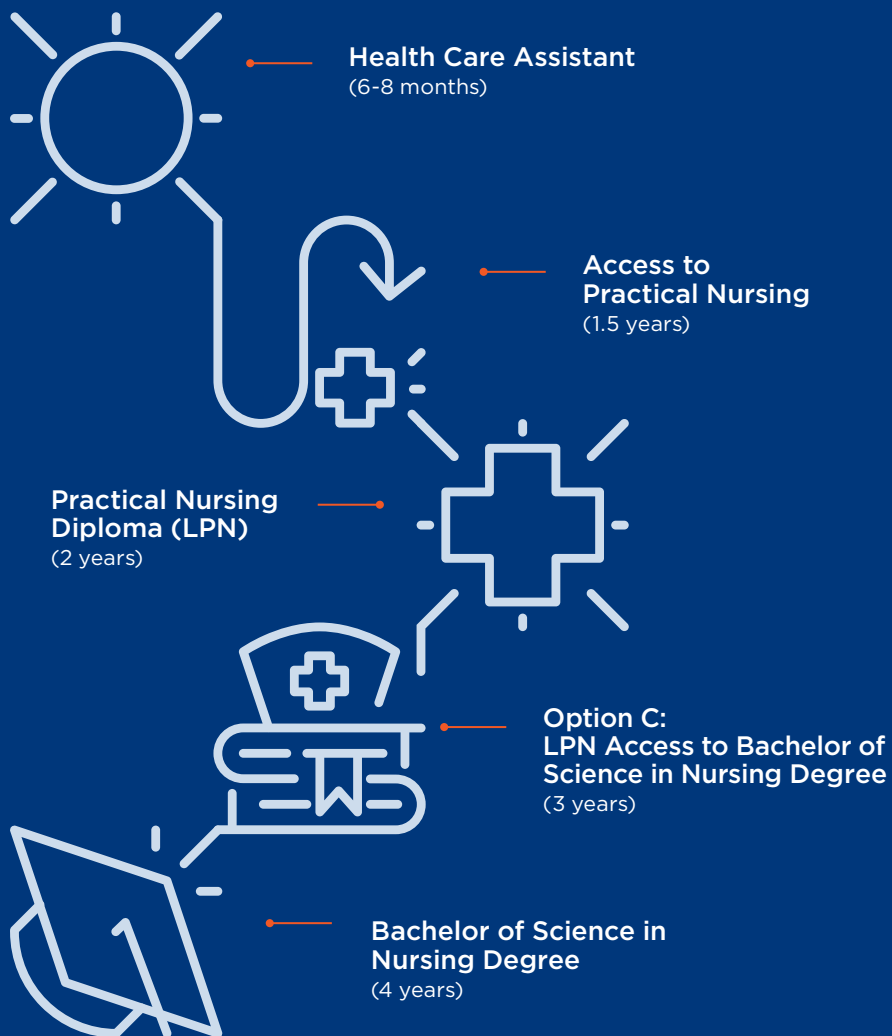

- 3 ACTIVATE YOUR MYNIC ACCOUNT**
Log in to mynic.nic.bc.ca with the username and password in your confirmation email.
- 4 SUBMIT YOUR TRANSCRIPTS**
Upload your official transcripts and any other documents required for your program.
- 5 CHECK YOUR MYNIC ACCOUNT FOR YOUR OFFER OF ADMISSION**
Accept your offer and pay your tuition deposit.
- 6 REGISTER FOR YOUR COURSES**
Choose courses in self-service in your myNIC account.
