Senior Citizen Tuition Exemption Guidelines

Canadian citizens and permanent residents of BC who have reached the age of 65 before the first day of classes and who wish to register in a North Island College University Transfer course may be exempt from paying tuition if they register during the add/drop period (that is, during the first ten days for the Fall and Winter terms and first five days for the Spring and Summer terms).

Seniors may apply to have their tuition waived if:

- seniors are not displacing a fee paying student
- seniors present proof of meeting the age requirements
- seniors meet course prerequisites
- seniors pay all other associated fees (lab, student society fees, materials, etc.)
- there is sufficient enrollment to warrant running the course

The tuition exemption for seniors is subject to the following conditions:

- seniors cannot receive a tuition waiver more than once for the same course
- seniors cannot apply for a waiver for more than one course per term
- seniors cannot receive tuition waivers for more than three courses per calendar year
- seniors cannot receive a tuition waiver for a course they have registered in prior to the add/drop period

The College reserves the right to limit the maximum number of tuition fee waivers available for seniors.

Senior citizens who wish to ensure registration in a specific course may do so by registering and paying in the same manner as a fee-paying student. Seniors that have been approved for tuition waiver will have the choice to register as an audit or credit student.
