

LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR'S MEDAL 2012

A medal in the name of the Lieutenant-Governor of British Columbia is awarded annually to a North Island College student graduating from a vocational program of studies of less than two years in length - but more than six months in duration if taken on a full-time basis - in the 2011/2012 educational year. The student chosen to receive this award will not only have excelled in their studies, but will have contributed in a positive way to the life of the College or of the community.

Candidates must demonstrate qualities such as initiative, a willingness to help others and general good citizenship qualities. The competition is open to any student at North Island College who meets the eligibility criteria outlined above.

3. Supply two letters of reference with your application. An appropriate reference is a previous employer, a volunteer coordinator or a community professional who can attest to your exemplary qualities. Please do **not** get a letter from your instructor.
4. Return the completed application form and the requested letters to the Financial Aid office on your campus **by the deadline date of April 13, 2012**. This award is competitive and is adjudicated by an Awards Selection Committee in May. The successful applicant will be notified in early June.
5. The medal will be conveyed to the recipient at their North Island College Graduation Ceremony in June.
