PREAMBLE

A successful pilot project was carried out in 1986/87 at the Comox Valley Centre, the purpose of which was to ban all smoking inside the premises.

By Board of Governors resolution No. 2677, September 16, 1987, the no smoking policy for the Comox Valley Centre was extended permanently by declaring it a smoke-free facility.

All of the other campuses/centres of the College region have since 1975 banned smoking from instructional areas, and provided a designated smoking area within each building.

The Provincial Government has implemented effective January 1, 1991, the regulation banning smoking from the interior of all government buildings.

POLICY

It is the Policy of North Island College effective June 1, 1991, to provide a smoke-free environment for all students, employees and visitors. Smoking is prohibited from the interior of all College facilities and buildings, whether rented, leased or owned.
