

## Professional Photography - Portfolio Requirements

To be accepted into the Photography program, you must first submit a portfolio. The following guidelines will help you prepare a strong portfolio:

- All images must be created by you.
- The portfolio should contain a representative selection of up to 20 prints and/or digital images.
- The committee is looking for self-initiated works, as well as assigned projects. Submissions can include working studies or completed examples of your work.
- Commercially produced prints, CD and DVD submissions are welcome. No slides, please.
- Maximum print size is 8 x 10. All works must be clearly identified with your name.
- Present your work in an organized fashion. Do not submit works that are matted or framed.
- Arrange your portfolio to best illustrate your developments, ie. over a sequence of time, by subject, by idea, etc.
- Package and label your portfolio appropriately. Remember to include return postage if necessary.
- Include a statement of expectations of 300 words, which will give the committee an indication of your communication skills.
