APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- The Application Form is located on the NIC website at www.nic.bc.ca/awards/apply.aspx
- Applications must be received by April 30, 2013
- Scan through the online application and gather your resources before you begin.
- Review the Award criteria carefully. You will only be considered for awards for which you are eligible.
- Check all Awards that you wish to apply for. You may apply for multiple awards using one application.
- Do some research and think through your costs and budget to make an accurate estimate of your income and expenses.
- Take the time to describe your financial need and responsibilities in the Additional Financial Information section.
- Take the time to expand on your personal circumstances in the *Personal Information* section.
 - The selection committee can only consider your circumstances if they are explained clearly.
- An application is considered to be incomplete without an attached copy of your transcript. Continuing students may request an electronic copy of their transcript from Student Services.
- · An application is considered to be incomplete if the application fields are not ALL filled in.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered by the selection committee.

Scholarships are funds awarded to students for academic achievement. **Unless otherwise noted, scholarships are awarded to full-time students taking a minimum 24 credits.

Bursaries

Bursaries are funds designed to assist students who demonstrate financial need. Students must meet specific eligibility criteria and must submit an application. Please refer to the application instructions in this booklet.

Scholarships and bursaries <u>must be used</u> in the year they are awarded, and in most cases, awards will be applied to tuition fees for entering and continuing students.

This award is available to a Port Alberni student enrolled in biology studies at the Port Alberni campus and who is enrolled in biology studies. The recipient will have demonstrated an interest in working in the field of fisheries resources and/or directed at a career in the biological sciences. Students applying for this award must have demonstrated financial need and maintained a satisfactory academic standing.

Rotary Club of Port Alberni Bursary

3 awards of \$500

These entrance awards are available to North Island College students who are Port Alberni residents attending the Port Alberni campus. The first award is for a student entering the Welding program. The second award is for a student entering the Automotive Services Technician Foundation program. The third award is for a student entering the Joinery/Cabinetmaking Foundation program.

Tim Fletcher Memorial Bursary

\$695

This entrance bursary, created through the generosity of Tim's family and friends is available to a North Island College student enrolling in the Automotive Service Technician Foundation program at the Port Alberni campus. The recipient must reside in Port Alberni and have a demonstrated financial need.

Continuing or Graduating

Alberni Valley Lions Club Bursary

2 awards of \$500

The recipient of this award must reside in Port Alberni and be a continuing student who has completed the first year of any North Island College program. The recipient will have maintained a satisfactory academic standing and have a demonstrated financial need. Citizenship and involvement within the College and the community will also be considered

Alberni Valley Medical Society Bursary

\$225

This award is available to a student at North Island College's Port Alberni campus whose goal is to pursue education and/or training in the health care profession. The recipient must have successfully completed at least one semester of study and be continuing on a full or part-time basis. Students applying for this award must have demonstrated financial need and have maintained a satisfactory academic standing.

Arrowsmith Rotary Club Bursary

\$500

This award is available to a student who is continuing their education and who has demonstrated volunteer service and/or service to the Port Alberni community. The recipient must have demonstrated financial need.

Dr Michael Trumper Memorial Bursary

\$350

This award has been created in memory of Dr. Michael Trumper, a well known and respected doctor who served the community of Port Alberni. The recipient of the award must be a North Island College female student attending the Port Alberni campus who has overcome obstacles to return to school and upgrade/improve her education.

Duncan Sabine Collyer Partners CGA Bursary

\$500

This award is available to a North Island College Port Alberni campus student who has completed the Office Management program or Applied Business Technology program with an interest in accounting.

John Squire Memorial Bursary

\$200

This bursary has been created by the Port Alberni & District Labour Council in memory of John Squire in recognition of his many years of faithful public service. The award is available to a North Island College student attending Port Alberni campus on a full or part-time basis. The recipient will be upgrading their academic skills in preparation for further education or to enter the workforce. Preference will be given to a union member, or family member.

Kinsman Club of Port Alberni Bursary

2 awards of \$500

This award is available to a North Island College student attending the Port Alberni campus on a full or part-time basis. The recipient must have a satisfactory academic standing and a demonstrated financial need. The award will be presented to a student who has is actively involved in community service.

Port Alberni Campus Administrators' Scholarship*

STBA

This award is provided by donations from the administrators of North Island College's Port Alberni campus. The scholarship is available to an outstanding student who has demonstrated leadership, citizenship, and has worked to enhance campus life.

Port Alberni Association of Community Living Bursary

2 awards of \$250

This award is available to a worthy student in the Human Services program demonstrating an interest in the field of developmental disabilities and children with special needs.

Port Alberni Campus Bursary

\$570

This award is available to an entering or continuing student attending the Port Alberni campus. The student must have a demonstrated financial need. Students applying for this bursary must submit a brief outline summarizing how the bursary would contribute to their continuing education and/or employment upgrading goals.

Port Alberni ElderCollege Bursary

\$500

Established by the Port Alberni ElderCollege in memory of founding members Hans Affourtit and Val Hughes, this award supports a mature student continuing their studies in any program offered at North Island College's Port Alberni campus. The recipient must be a resident of Port Alberni, either a full or part-time student who works very hard at his/her studies, and demonstrates financial need. Preference will be given to a student who has actively volunteered in the community. In addition to the personal statement, applicants should include at least two letters of reference; one from a current instructor, and the others from community agencies where the applicant has volunteered. The award will be applied to tuition.

Port Alberni Salmon Festival Society Bursary

\$500

This award is available to a Port Alberni student enrolled in biology studies at the Port Alberni campus. The recipient will have demonstrated an interest in working in the field of fisheries resources and/or career in the biological sciences. Students applying for the award must have demonstrated financial need and maintained a satisfactory academic standing.

Rhoda Campbell Memorial - Early Childhood Education Scholarship

\$405

This scholarship is available to a full-time student who has successfully completed the Early Childhood Care & Education program at the Port Alberni campus. The recipient must have excelled in the area of practice.

Robert Illman Memorial Welding Bursary

\$595

The recipient of this award will be a North Island College student who is registered full-time in the Welding Program at the Port Alberni campus. The award will be granted to a student who has a demonstrated financial need and has maintained a satisfactory academic and practical achievement in the Welding program.

Simo Nurme Memorial Scholarship*

\$405

This scholarship, created by the staff and faculty of the Port Alberni campus and Port Alberni ElderCollege, is in memory of Simo Nurme, North Island College faculty member and President of the Port Alberni Historical Society. The award will be granted on the basis of academic achievement to a full or part-time student who has successfully completed at least one of the history courses offered at the Port Alberni campus and who has demonstrated a strong and keen interest in history.

Umeek Scholarship* \$250

This award is available to a North Island College student of self-declared aboriginal origin with the most improved grades in maths and sciences over a period of 2 years. The recipient will be enrolled in either first or second year University level maths and sciences at the Port Alberni campus.

CAMPUS SPECIFIC – MT. WADDINGTON

David N Hudson Bursary

\$315

This award, created in honour of a long-standing educator with North Island College, is available for a student enrolled in a North Island College distance course(s). The student must have a demonstrated financial need and may be entering or continuing their studies at NIC. Preference will be given to a student attending North Island College's Mt. Waddington campus, or an NIC Centre.

Grieg Seafood BC Ltd Bursary

\$1000

This entrance award is available to an entering or continuing student at North Island College. The recipient will be enrolling in a program of courses that relate to marine biology, biology, or similar area of study. The student receiving this award must be a resident of a community of Nootka Sound, Campbell River, adjacent islands or the North Island region.

Mt. Waddington Campus - Applied Business Technology

\$520

This award is available to a continuing full or part-time student attending the North Island College Mt. Waddington campus or an NIC Centre. The recipient will be an Applied Business Technology student who has shown great perseverance in working towards their educational goals and must have maintained a satisfactory academic standing.

Mt. Waddington Campus - Maths/Science Award

\$TBA

This award is available to a continuing full or part-time student attending the Mt. Waddington campus or taking distance courses through the Mt. Waddington campus. The student preferably will be taking a University Transfer math course or be upgrading their math for this purpose. If there is not a suitable math student, then a student upgrading their chemistry or biology or taking a university level biology course may be considered. Students applying for this bursary must have a demonstrated financial need and must have maintained a satisfactory academic standing.

Shirley Wagner Memorial Scholarship*

\$1020

This award is available to a student attending North Island College at any location other than the Comox Valley campus. The recipient of this award will have completed first year English in the preceding term and successfully completed at least two other first year University Transfer courses. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the highest grades achieved in the first year English course.

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

60% Course Load

Typically three, three credit courses per semester; also considered full-time studies at North Island College.

Academic Program

A program of study, usually involving theoretical knowledge and research, and usually leading to a diploma, associate degree or bachelor's degree.

Associate Degree in Arts

Associate degree is the completion of 60 credits of study, which is approximately 20 courses. Students can complete the first two years of a Bachelor of Arts degree at North Island College by obtaining their Associate Degree in Arts.

Associate Degree in Science

Associate degree is the completion of 60 credits of study, which is approximately 20 courses. Students can complete the first two years of a Bachelor of Science degree at North Island College by obtaining their Associate Degree in Science.

Associated Study

Student registered in Communications, Journalism or associated study. In this context, associated study refers to a student taking courses with topics that are related to this field or that prepare the student for employment in that particular field.

Career Program

A program of study designed to equip a student with the skills and general educational background needed for employment in a specific field, (e.g. Early Childhood Care & Education, Health Care Assistant, Practical Nursing, Tourism).

Communications

Study and/or employment relating to the principles of transmitting information and the methods by which it is delivered as in print or radio or television (e.g. English, Journalism, Creative Writing).

Continuing Student

A continuing student has completed a term or semester of courses and is eligible to register in courses the following semester.

Credit Program

A credit is the value assigned to a course. For example, many NIC courses are valued at 3 credits. Credit programs require the completion of a certain number of credits/courses to graduate from the program.

Entrance

Refers to the status of a student who is attending courses at North Island College for the first time.

Environmental Sciences

North Island College offers an Associate of Science Degree / University Transfer Science (60 credits) which can be applied towards completing an Environmental Sciences degree and a career in the field. Jobs include: Environmental Protection, Conservation and Preservation of Natural Resources and Environmental Education, Communication and Research.

Field of Computing Technology

Study and or employment in the activity of designing, constructing and programming computers. Computer courses at NIC can be located under CPS - Info Tech & Computing Science and IMG - Interactive Media.

Fine Arts

The study and creation of visual works of art. Subjects range from photography and digital visual art to sculpture and ceramics. Students at NIC can take a Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree, Fine Arts Diploma, Professional Photography Certificate, Interactive Media (Advanced Communication Design Diploma, Communication Design Diploma, Web Design Certificate, Web Design Diploma).

Full-Time

Enrolment in at least a 60% course load for program of studies; typically three, 3-credit courses (nine credits per semester).

Graduating Student

A graduating student is currently enrolled in a program and will graduate within the upcoming term.

Industrial Training Program

A program of study, that adheres to the Industrial Training Authority guidelines, that provides students with specific training for a select profession. Typically there are different levels a student must reach before receiving a final designation. For example, a Red Seal ticketed Electrician must successfully complete 4 levels of study before achieving a Red Seal ticket in the electrical trade.

Mature Student

23 years or older in the calendar year at the time of registration.

New

A student who has never attended NIC previously; A student who has not attended NIC for 5 or more years; A student who has taken upgrading courses only (ABE level) and who has been admitted to a post secondary program at NIC. Does not include students beginning a 'new' post secondary program (e.g. transferring from Fine Arts to Science).

North Island College Student

A student who is paying tuition to North Island College.

Nursing Program

Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree, Practical Nursing.

Part-Time

Enrolment in less than 60% course load for program of studies. Less than three, three credit courses (less than nine credits per semester).

Program

A program is a defined plan of studies that may result in a certificate, diploma or degree.

Registered student

Has paid a tuition deposit and will be registered in program.

Science Program

Associate of Science Degree; Bachelor of Science Prep; Dental Hygiene Prep; Kinesiology Prep; Medical Prep; Pharmacy Prep; First Year Engineering.

Social Sciences

Social science uses the scientific method to explore aspects of human society and development, such as anthropology, criminology, economics, geography, political science, psychology, sociology, and women's studies.

Technical Program

A program of study that directly develops a student's expertise in a particular group of techniques or technology; Also referred to as a Vocational Program (e.g. Drafting, Electronics).

Trades Program

Programs at North Island College include: Aircraft Structures; Drafting; Electronics; Welding; Metal Fabricaton; Automotive Service; Carpentry; Electrical; Heavy Duty & Commercial Mechanics; Joinery/Cabinetmaking; Millwright; Plumbing & Pipefitting.

University Level Course

University Studies courses are listed as 100 (first year), 200 (second year), 300 (third year) and 400 (fourth year) course levels.

University Level Studies

At North Island College University Studies can be for personal interest or used to TRANSFER in part or in full to other institutions and can be applied towards diplomas, associate degrees, or bachelor's degrees at NIC and beyond.

Vocational Program

A program of study that provides specific training directly related to a particular job; Also referred to as a Technical Program, (e.g. Drafting, Electronics, Culinary Arts).
