Construction Begins on NIC's Trades Training Facility

North Island College is excited to announce that construction has begun on its new Trades Training facility at the Comox Valley campus. Excavators began their work to prepare the building site on January 4th, 2010. Construction of the 2,152 square metres, or 23,164 square feet, facility is scheduled to be complete and ready for occupancy by the end of the year, with classes scheduled to begin January 2011.

The skills development and trades training centre will house carpentry and multi-purpose workshops, a covered open work area, washroom and offices, and three trades training classrooms, with an additional unfinished space that can remain flexible for future expansion.



The skills development and trades training centre at North Island College is jointly funded by the federal and provincial governments through the Knowledge Infrastructure Program, whose goal is to repair and expand research and educational facilities at Canadian post-secondary institutions.
