Vacuum Casting

Create a one-of-a-kind ring that will be carved, cast and finished in only two days. On the first day, you will learn to size and carve a ring in wax and then invest it to prepare for the cast. On day two, you will learn how to pour the metal, saw off the sprue, clean and polish your ring. This course is suitable for any jewellery-making student, beginner to advanced, who wants the opportunity to cast with professional equipment and instruction.

Supply Fee:

Your course fee includes supplies you will receive in class to complete your project.

Supplies and Materials required (to bring from home):

- Safety glasses (mandatory)
- Face dust mask (N95 rating)
- Reading glasses or magnification such as an Optivisor if needed.
- Shop apron
- Writing or graph paper for designing
- Small bristle brushes for texture or matte finish
- Any personal hand tools you have acquired (files, pliers, etc.)
- Any dremel or foredom tools that you have at home (sanding discs, small burs, etc).

Bring a bagged lunch and beverage as a short break will be taken.

Please wear close-toed shoes (no sandals) for safety and bring something to tie long hair back.
