### Course Information:

Create a sterling silver spinner (meditation) ring; a great one-day project for all levels. Through demonstrations and step-by-step instructions, you will learn basic jewellery fabrication techniques including accurately measuring metal, filing, texturing and soldering. Complete the day by learning some finishing techniques to add those final touches to your ring.

Note: Materials are provided and included in the price.

### Supplies to Bring from Home:

- Safety glasses (mandatory)
- Reading glasses or magnification such as an optivisor if needed.
- Face dust mask (N95 rating).
- Old soft cloth (flannel preferred) or hand towel.
- Small ball peen hammer (if you already have one).
- Any small pliers used for jewellery (no teeth) if you have them.
- Small tool box or container for your tools.
- Tie backs for long hair.
- Shop apron (if you have one).
- Writing paper or sketch book and pencil/pen.
- Sharpie permanent ink fine tip pen.
- Any pictures of designs that inspire you.
