Designated Inspection Facility Operator

Prepare for your Designated Inspection Facility Operator exam in this one-day course. Course content covers applicable regulations, legislation and vehicle inspection program requirements. You will gain the required knowledge to effectively participate in the BC Vehicle Inspection Program and ensure that vehicles inspected at your facility meet all applicable safety standards for on-highway use.

A DIF operator has many legal responsibilities. It is imperative that all DIF operators have awareness and working knowledge of all applicable Motor Vehicle Act, Motor Vehicle Act Regulations and Vehicle Inspection Program requirements. The goal of the DIF operator training course is to provide education in program objectives, authorized inspector obligations and a clear recognition of both operator responsibilities and liabilities.

<u>Effective December 1, 2013</u>, all new DIF Operator's must complete the DIF Operator Training Course **prior** to application submission. Documentation of course completion must be submitted with the new facility application package. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

There are no pre-requisites for enrollment in the DIF Operator Training Course and any Authorized Inspector or current operators may participate.

- Relevant parts of the Motor Vehicle Act and Regulations and other handouts
