Centrifugal Casting

Students will create a wax carved ring or pendant that will be cast into sterling silver and completed into a finished piece of jewellery. They will learn how to create a wax model and cast their creation using the combination of lost wax and centrifugal casting methods. This carving method is very forgiving and suits the beginner who would like to experiment with the casting method of creating jewellery. Those with jewellery-making or carving experience will have the opportunity to work on more complex pieces

Supply Fee:

Your course fee includes supplies you will receive in class to complete your project.

Supplies and materials <u>required</u> to bring from home:

- safety glasses
- reading glasses or magnification such as an Optivisor if needed
- leather or denim apron
- old tea towel

Optional (if you already have these):

- small carving tools (like dental picks)
- metal files- 6" flat or needle files
- small rasp file

Bring a bagged lunch and beverage as a short break will be taken.
