Student Commons rises from the concrete

NIC's Student Commons, future home to a new Library and Learning Commons, took shape this month as crews began installing the steel structure and 52-foot structural engineered beams on Oct. 9. Ten days later, the campus celebrated the construction milestone with campus tours. Additional tours are being planned this winter.



STATUS UPDATE

Aircraft Structures Building: Excavations have started and the foundations will be formed shortly. Please drive carefully - the roadway near D-Wing will be narrowed during construction.

Timberline Trades Building: Occupation permit issued and in use by Timberline Secondary students.

Trades/Aquaculture Building: Occupation permit issued. Two classrooms now in use, plus a temporary library, bookstore, washrooms and showers.

Heavy Duty Shop: Majority of construction complete; being used as storage for construction materials. The shops are expected to be home to students next fall.

D-Wing: Nursing lab renovations began this fall in the former Timberline media area.
