Specialize in Canadian and international business management, including trade, marketing and finance.





Mentorship

NIC offers mentorship opportunities through partnerships with the Comox Valley and Campbell River Chambers of Commerce. The goal of the mentorship program is to connect top business students with working professionals in the business community to share their knowledge and experience with a new generation of business leaders.

Work-Integrated Learning

Work-integrated learning allows students to gain workplace experience while enrolled in academic programs.

NIC is an accredited co-op institution with Co-Operative Education and Work-Integrated Learning Canada (CEWIL), the lead organization for work-integrated learning (WIL) in Canada.



NIC is also a member of the Association for Co-operative Education and Work-Integrated Learning BC/Yukon (ACE-WIL), supporting research efforts that enable students, partner organizations and members.



CO-OP

Co-operative education is a paid work-integrated learning opportunity, allowing you to combine your academic studies with practical experience by alternating periods of full-time study with full-time paid work.

Your co-op designation demonstrates that you combine academic training and relevant work experience to transition into employment successfully. Employers across Canada recognize the quality of co-op training and experience.



INTERNSHIP

Build your network of business contacts while gaining work experience. An internship is a type of work-integrated learning where you apply theories and methods learned in the classroom to situations and challenges in the workplace. Interns can learn new skills and create professional contacts that will enhance future employment and support career success.
