You can either come dressed in your gown, or put it on once you arrive. If you plan to get your gown on at the campus, please arrive early, to ensure you're dressed and ready for photos by 12:30pm. Please leave all valuables at home.</p> <p>Once you've had your class photo taken, please plan to be back in the bistro by 1:30pm to begin lining up for the processional.</p> <p>The Graduation Ceremony will commence promptly at 2:00pm.</p> <p>Class photos will be taken in the cafeteria. Weather permitting we will use the courtyard. Class and stage photos will be emailed to your myNIC email address approximately 2 weeks after grad. Attire:	Since this is a formal ceremony recognizing significant achievements, the College expects all graduates crossing the stage to wear regalia.
Seating:	Graduates will enter the room with their graduating class during the processional, and will be seated together in reserved seats.
Guests:	<p>Guests enter through the lower/north entrance near cafeteria. Staff will be available to direct guests to appropriate seating. There is no reserved seating.</p> <p>We ask that all grads and their guests remain seated until the end of the ceremony so that we can properly recognize all participants.</p>
Reception:	The College will provide light refreshments for graduates and their guests after the ceremony.
Credentials:	Graduates will receive their official certificate or diploma in the mail, not at the ceremony. You must have completed the Application for Credential form to receive your credential.
