 - Indigenous Education updates:

- o NIC has two Indigenous language fluency certificates and is also offering the Indigenous Leadership Certificate with strong enrollment. These courses are being offered digitally.
- o The new Gathering Place in Campbell River will open officially at the end of the September.
- Check out the joint publication, *Journeying Together: A Transformative Approach to Indigenization and Internationalization at North Island College*
- Education Team updates:
 - Adult Basic Education (ABE)department will be moving into the Arts, Science and Technology division and the Department of Accessible Learning (DAL) will be moving into the Health and Human Services division.
