Online* English Placement (ACCUPLACER)

ACCUPLACER is an online placement, composed of three sections: reading comprehension, sentence structure (Writing Skills), and essay writing (WritePlacer).

The reading and writing skills sections are comprised of 20 multiple-choice questions per section. WritePlacer evaluates your ability to write effective essays, which is a critical component to academic success. All sections are untimed; however, the average time to complete all three sections is 2.5-3 hours. You will receive your results within a week (often sooner) of sitting the ACCUPLACER. If you are taking the ACCUPLACER at the Comox Valley campus, it may be possible to receive your results on the same day. Results will also be inputted into our system and forwarded to the Admissions office.

The following areas will be covered in the online math placement for the above program:

Area of Study	Minimum Score	Details	Time
Arithmetic	257+	Operations with whole numbers, decimals and per cents. Applications and problem solving (per cent, measurement, simple geometry).	untimed
Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra and Statistics	267+	Rational numbers, ratio and proportion, exponents, algebraic expressions, linear equations, linear applications and graphs, probability sets, descriptive statistics and geometry concepts.	untimed
Advanced Algebra and Functions	235+	Linear equations, applications and graphs, factoring, quadratics, functions, radical and rational equations, polynomial equations, exponential and logarithmic equations and trigonometry.	untimed
