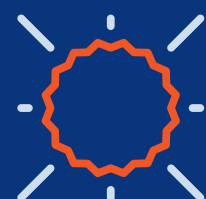
## Dual credit

### ① Choose a program

Apply early to secure your spot. Applications open in October for the following school year.

### ② Submit your application

Sign up to [educationplannerbc.ca](https://educationplannerbc.ca), fill out your application and pay the \$25 fee.

After we've received your application from EPBC, we'll send confirmation to your personal email address.

Be sure to add @nic.bc.ca to your safe sender list.

### ③ Activate your myNIC account

Log in to [mynic.nic.bc.ca](https://mynic.nic.bc.ca) with the username and password in your confirmation email.

### ④ Submit your transcripts

Request your official transcripts through the Ministry of Education. They will send them to NIC on your behalf.

### ⑤ Check your email for your offer of admission

Accept your offer and pay your tuition deposit.

### ⑥ Register for your courses

Choose courses in self-service in your myNIC account.
