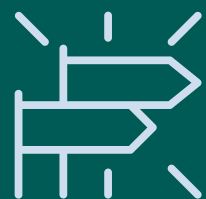

Work towards your Red Seal in the trades, find your creative edge in the culinary arts or prepare for employment with industry training.



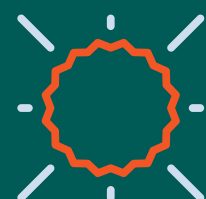
## Dual credit

Start your Youth Train in Trades Program in Grade 11 or 12. Your tuition may be covered. Talk to your high school counsellor/coordinator.

## Red Seal Pathway

- Foundation (pre-apprenticeship/Level 1) 24-36 weeks
- Apprenticeship Levels 1-4 5-10 weeks in-class per level, remainder with sponsor employer.

### ① Choose a program

Explore programs and admission requirements at [nic.bc.ca/programs](http://nic.bc.ca/programs)

Apply early to secure your spot. Applications open in October for the following school year.

### ② Submit your application

Sign up to [educationplannerbc.ca](http://educationplannerbc.ca), fill out your application and pay the \$25 fee.

After we've received your application from EPBC, we'll send confirmation to your personal email address.

Be sure to add @nic.bc.ca to your safe sender list.

### ③ Activate your myNIC account

Log in to [mynic.nic.bc.ca](http://mynic.nic.bc.ca) with the username and password in your confirmation email.

### ④ Submit your transcripts

Request your official transcripts through the Ministry of Education. They will send them to NIC on your behalf.

### ⑤ Check your email for your offer of admission

Accept your offer and pay your tuition deposit.
