

# NIC Fast Facts - Enrolment and Financial Context

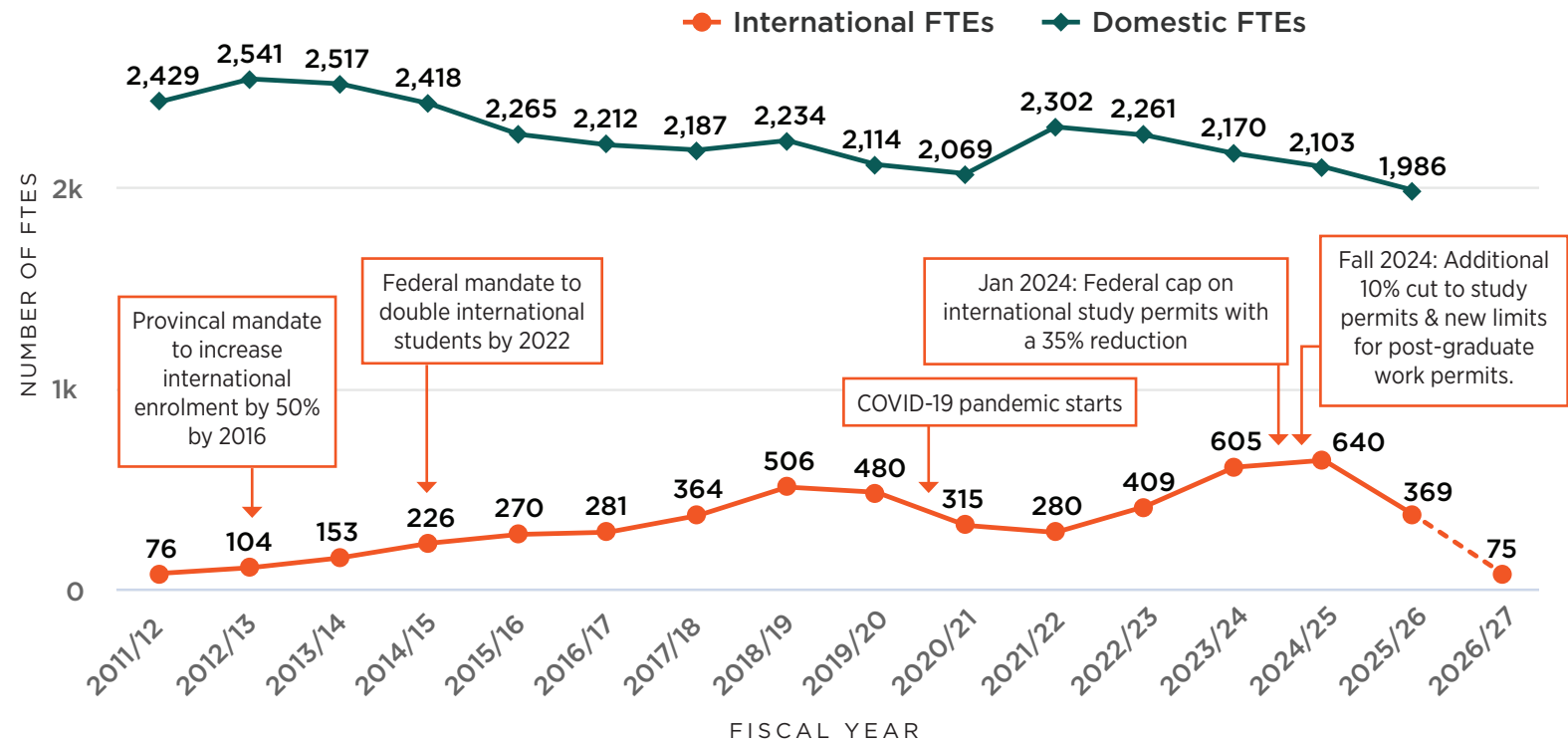
## Introduction

Post-secondary institutions (PSI), following years of government-mandated growth, have been facing serious challenges around international student enrolment due to federal policy changes the last two years: reduced student permits, a cap on international students and strict guidelines on programs eligible for post-graduate work permits. At NIC, these decisions have impacted operations in many ways: enrolment, revenue, programs and services, even new housing.

## Enrolment Updates: 25/26 Full-time Enrolments (FTEs)<sup>1</sup>

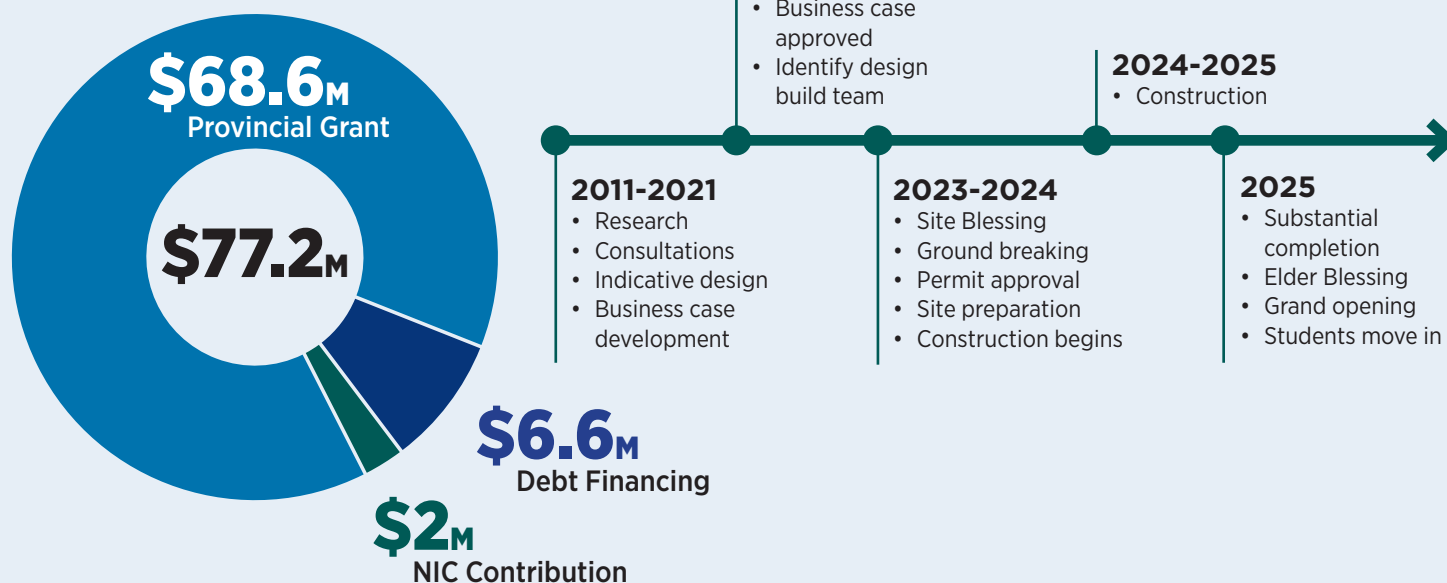
## Expedited Program Impact Assessment

- The Expedited Program Impact Assessment (EPIA) is a two-step review process.
- Step One was completed in October 2025, and Step Two has now concluded.
- This work has taken place during a period of significant financial pressure for post-secondary institutions across Canada.
- EPIA process is an important step in ensuring our programs remain efficient, sustainable and responsive.
- The EPIA also reflects our responsibility to manage the college's resources and mitigate our budget deficit.
- At the Feb. 5 meeting, NIC's Board of Governors considered suspension recommendations for 15 programs.
- When programs are suspended, additional actions follow, including meetings with faculty and the Registrar to explore next steps and develop teaching-out plans for students to complete credentials.
