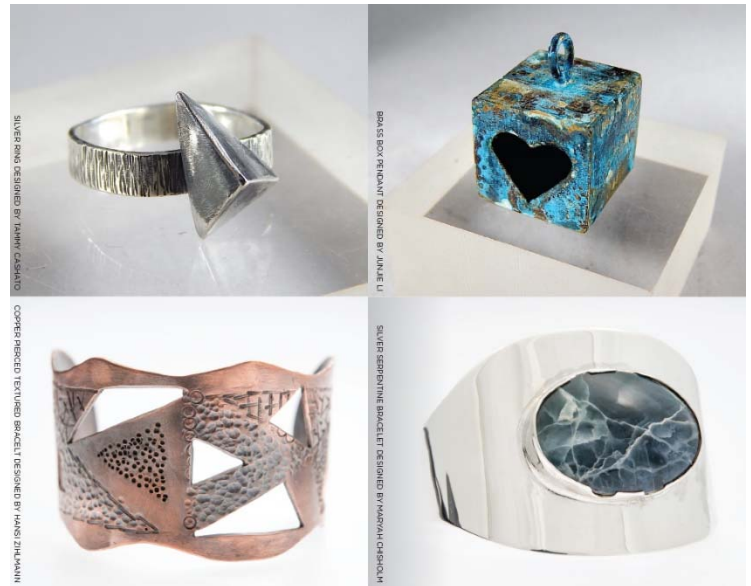
Visitors can learn more about the Metal Jewellery Design certificate starting again this fall, as well as individual jewellery workshops and courses this spring and summer.
