FUNDAMENTALS OF MIXING WATERCOLOURS (CREC 1500)

WORKSHOP SUPPLY LIST

PAINTS: Student or artist quality - NO POSTER PAINT

Ideally you will bring at <u>least</u> a **warm** and a **cool** of each primary. (a few suggestions below)

WARM

- New Gamboge **OR** Cadmium Yellow
- Winsor Red OR Cadmium Red
- Winsor Blue (reds shade) **OR** French Ultramarine

COOL

- Lemon Yellow OR Winsor Lemon
- Permanent Rose **OR** Permanent Alizarin Crimson
- Cerulean Blue OR Cobalt Blue

PLUS: Burnt Umber (warm) AND Raw Sienna (cool)

WATERCOLOUR BRUSH REQUIREMENTS:

- 3/4" or 1" flat brush
- 1 or 2 smaller flats or filberts
- A couple of round brushes (size # 5 to 8)

Bring what you have and we'll work with them (as long as they're **watercolour brushes** - synthetics are fine).

WATERCOLOUR PAPER:

We will not have time to stretch paper in class so your paper should be 260 to 300 LB Cold Press Artist Quality Paper or a 140 LB (or heavier) **watercolour block**.

Minimum of 2 pieces measuring 7¹/₂ X 11" each (paper for exercises will be provided)

OTHER SUPPLIES REQUIRED:

- Support board for securing your paper: it should measure approximately 12" X
 16" (white plastic corrugated sign board will do)
- Palette: white and large enough to mix your paints and with enough wells to hold the above paints
- Kleenex tissue & Paper Towel
- Pencil 2H, ruler & erasure
- 2 water containers (preferably plastic) one for cleaning; the other for mixing your paints (yogurt containers are a good choice)
- Masking tape: 1" to $1^{1}/_{2}$ inch wide blue painter's tape works well
