## Repoussé

Learn to push metal into 3D form with one of the most exciting of all jewellery techniques: repoussé. Your instructor will demonstrate several repoussé and chasing techniques, teaching you how to prepare a pitch bowl and work with soft copper to create a piece of wearable art. No previous experience is necessary.

## **Supply Fee:**

Your course fee includes supplies you will receive in class to complete your project.

## Supplies and Materials required (to bring from home):

- Safety glasses (mandatory)
- Reading glasses or magnification such as an Optivisor if needed.
- Shop apron
- Ball peen hammer
- Simple design motifs
- Any chasing and repoussé tools you have acquired
- Writing or graph paper for designing and notes

We recommend that you Google the repoussé technique prior to class to get a general idea of what you will be learning.

Bring a bagged lunch and beverage as a short break will be taken. Please wear close-toed shoes (no sandals) for safety and bring something to tie long hair back.
