Using sterling silver plate and wire, learn tips and techniques to fabricate designer earrings — without soldering. You will saw, pierce, punch, texturize, file, patina and polish the silver plate into interesting earring components. By combining those pieces with three different styles of silver wire earring hooks, you will create six pairs of beautiful earrings. A great course for beginners.

Supply Fee:

Your course fee includes supplies you will receive in class to complete your projects.

Supplies and Materials required (to bring from home):

- Safety glasses
- Silver polishing cloth
- Sharpie
- Ruler
- Knitting needles for jump rings
- Solid round tube lipstick
- BIC stick pen
- Face dust mask
- Silversmithing tools that you may have, including: jewelers saw frame and blades, texurizing hammers, metal files, small mandrels, needle nose pliers, round nose pliers, chain nose pliers, wire cutters, fine sanding file (we have some sets of these in studio but you may wish to bring your own and it always helps to have more in class)
