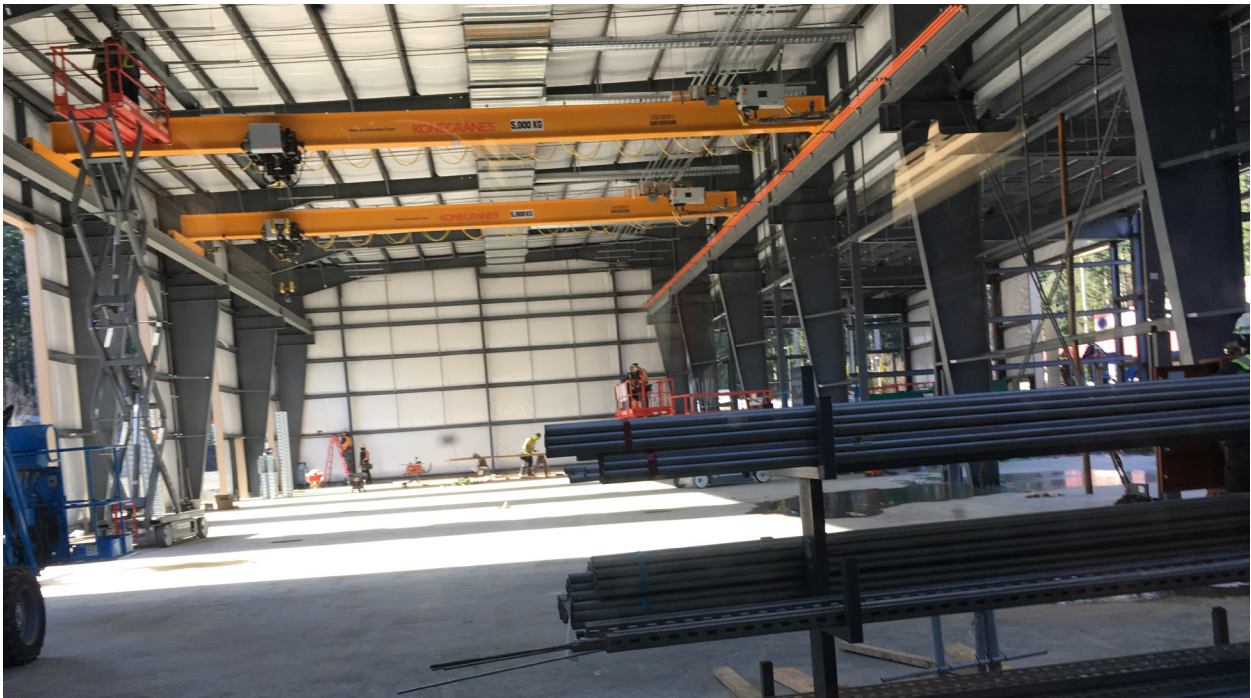


WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Cranes arrive for Heavy Duty Mechanics Shop (Building 100): Workers install two five-tonne overhead Konecranes in NIC's new Heavy Duty Mechanical shop in Campbell River. The shop is the first of five buildings being constructed in a \$17.6 million expansion of the Campbell River campus this year. It will be home to NIC's popular Heavy Duty Mechanical Foundation and Apprenticeship programs.



STATUS UPDATE

Timberline Trades Building (Building 500) and Trades/Aquaculture Building (Building 300): The structural steel is being installed for both buildings, despite the colder weather last week. Next up will be cladding and roofing - to catch up with the Heavy Duty Mechanics Shop pictured above.
