As part of program requirements, you are required to obtain several pieces of industry specific field gear. To alleviate confusion regarding the types of gear that are most appropriate, we have included a list and some examples to help you select any items you may need to purchase. These items include:

Caulk Boots	Rubber or half and half boots are recommended.	~\$150 - 250	
Suitable Rain Gear (Jacket should be roomy enough to wear over a cruising vest)	Heavy duty and 100% waterproof. GoreTex and other designer breathables are not recommended . Jackets must have a minimum of 200in ² of high-vis reflective. (worksafe cerified)	~\$100 Jacket ~\$100 Pants	
Cruisers Vest	This will be a forestry style cruisers vest, with a large zippered back pocket and lunch pouch. Inner harnesses are recommended but not required. Vests constructed of Cordura nylon are preferable to cotton. They must be orange (no other color) and must have a minimum of 200in ² of high-vis reflective.	~\$275-360 for an industry preferred vest with internal harness 80-100 for basic
