CONTEST PERIOD

North Island College's NICFest Instagram contest starts at 9:00am on Wednesday, March 6, 2024 (the Contest Start Date) and closes at 11:59:59pm on Friday, March 15, 2024 (the Contest Period). All times listed are in Pacific Time.

ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to residents of British Columbia, who have reached the age of majority in British Columbia (the "Entrant") at the Contest Start Date. The Contest is not open to employees of North Island College, North Island College's contractors, and contest suppliers, and members of their immediate families regardless of where they reside. For these rules, "immediate family" means mother, father, sister, brother, son, daughter and spouse.

HOW TO ENTER

To participate in the Contest, you must follow [@NorthIslandCollege](#) and "like" the contest post and tag one unique user and state a way to use the Visa gift card. Entry by Instagram only: entries who have met the eligibility will be pooled together into a group for the Prize draw. Winners will be drawn at random.

FORM ENTRY RULES

Your contest entry must be submitted via Instagram during the Contest Period. One (1) prize pack will be awarded at the end of the Contest Period. The total retail value of the prize pack is \$200 CAD. Draw date is Tuesday March 19 2024.

PRIZE

A Prize must be accepted as awarded, is non-refundable, cannot be replaced if lost or stolen, and is not convertible to cash. The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received during each Contest.

If a response is not received from a Selected Entrant within the prescribed time, the Prize may be forfeited and awarded to an alternate Entrant.
