



Program Articulation Agreement North Island College, Vancouver Island and VTC Academy, Vietnam

The program articulation agreement outlined hereafter are entered into in good faith by both institutions under the umbrella of the Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation signed 06/11/2020. The institutions undertake to co-operate to ensure that VTC Academy Full Stack Web Development and Mobile Application Development program graduates have access to North Island College (NIC) Advanced DIGITAL Design + Development Diploma, avoiding unnecessary obstructions, but nonetheless subject to the highest relevant academic standards.

Additionally, it should be noted that:

- Program articulation agreements are subject to review on a periodic basis by either institution or to a review being sought by either institution.
- All programs at both colleges are subject to periodic review and the outcome of such reviews will
 result in the review of the appropriate articulation agreement where necessary.
- Fulfilling the requirements of a program articulation agreement does not constitute a placement offer for that program.
- All applicants must provide documentary evidence of having successfully achieved the specific requirements of a particular articulation agreement.
- The provision of a program, or program stage, at NIC is subject to appropriate demand and available capacity. The existence of a program description in any promotional material from NIC does not constitute a legal undertaking that that program will be available the following academic year.

VTC Academy Full Stack Web Development and Mobile Application Development Programs

Recommended Point of Entry:

VTC graduates of the Full Stack Web Development and Mobile Application Development Programs are eligible to enter Year 2 of the Advanced DIGITAL Design + Development Diploma.

Grade Requirements:

To be eligible for consideration for entry to this NIC program, VTC graduates will have achieved a minimum grade point average of 2.5. This entry requirement is subject to periodic review. Prospective transfers who do not meet the requirements may be offered an alternate option to complete their degree that may require additional courses at NIC to achieve their diplomas.
