- 232 participants
- 14 participants self-identified as having Aboriginal Ancestry
- 47 girls
- 3 student instructors
- 3 volunteers
- 9 week-long camps
- 1 girls only workshop
- 7 North Island communities
- 7 community partners: Navigate, NSERC, Canada Summer Jobs, Campbell River Creative Industries Council, Hamber Foundation, Yuuṭuʔitʔath Government, and Engineers & Geoscientists of British Columbia.

Thanks to generous funding from our community partners, **232 students, ages 9 to 12**, had the opportunity to build, program and control Lego robots at a series of summer camps. Students participated in the camps from Port Alberni, the Comox Valley, Port Hardy, Campbell River, Tofino, Ucluelet and new this year, Gold River.

Students **learned vital science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) skills, required for many careers.** We also expanded on these valuable STEM skills by offering two additional new technology camps called the **Tech Explorers Camp.**
